


Creating PDF using QuarkXPress

Procedure for exporting to PDF using QuarkXPress v9.x

With past versions of QuarkXpress, we have found it best to export to postscript and use Acrobat Distiller to create the PDF. However, with QuarkXpress 7.x and higher we have found it best to export to PDF using the following settings:



Once in the **Output Styles** dialog box, click the **Import...** button



- Map to the location you placed the supplied **Sheridan Press_QX9** Output style.
- Choose it and click **Open**.

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Verify the Settings are as follows:






